

INTERSTATE AND INTERNATIONAL HEALTH CERTIFICATES

Interstate certificates are valid for 30 days. However, some airlines limit this to 10 days. Consult your airline directly.

International travel requirements are different for each country. The time frame for the completion of these requirements range from 2 weeks to 6 months or longer. International certificates are valid for 10 days. You will have to make an appointment with the USDA office in Atlanta after we issue the certificate prior to your travel date.

- 1) What is your full name, address, phone number, and county? Are you the owner of this pet?
- 2) What is the name of the person, address, phone number, and county of destination the pet is traveling to?
- 3) What is your pet's information – name, species, breed, color, sex, altered (spayed or neutered), and date of birth?
- 4) If international, what country are you traveling to?
- 5) When is your travel date? What is the travel method?
- 6) Where are your pet's medical records?
 - a. New Georgia Animal Hospital?
 - b. If other – where?
 - i. Request a copy be sent to us at newgah@hotmail.com
- 7) Does your pet have a microchip?
 - a. If yes – when was it placed?
 - b. Attach proof of date of placement with number and type of chip to newgah@hotmail.com
- 8) Is your pet current on its Rabies vaccination?
 - a. If yes:
 - i. When was it given? Where was it given?
 - b. ****Attach a copy of the Rabies certificate to this email****
 - c. **** bring the Rabies certificate with you to your appointment****
 - d. **** IF INTERNATIONAL- THE MICROCHIP MUST HAVE BEEN PLACED PRIOR TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE RABIES VACCINE****
 - i. If not microchipped prior to the Rabies vaccine, the Rabies vaccine will have to be re-administered usually 21 days prior to travel.
- 9) Has your pet had any other vaccines or tests (such as heartworm test, fecal or feline triple)?
 - a. If so what vaccines, and where?
 - b. **** Bring proof of those vaccines and tests with results with you ****
- 10) Is your pet demonstrating any signs of illness and/or injury?
- 11) Is your pet on any long-term medication? Any chronic illnesses or injuries?
- 12) IF INTERNATIONAL: Please give us the name of the person traveling with your pet. If this person is not the owner, we must have written authorization from the owner to carry out the non-commercial movement of the pet on behalf of the owner and this person **MUST** be present for the health certificate appointment.
